



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES ~ ADVANCEMENT OFFICE

Interested students are encouraged to apply for one of the following scholarships, which are open to all students in every major.

William S. Belvin Scholarship Fund

The purpose of this fund is to provide an annual scholarship for tuition and fees to one undergraduate student enrolled in a full time degree-granting program for at least three semesters, who has demonstrated the capacity to succeed at Plymouth State University, and has maintained a GPA of 3.2 over at least three semesters. Students must provide information of their own financial contribution and commitment toward the cost of their education. Preference may be given to students who are the first in their family to seek a baccalaureate degree.

Harold E. Hyde Scholarship Fund

The purpose of this endowed fund is to provide a scholarship to a student who demonstrates a strong record of academic achievement. Criteria includes an exemplary record of leadership and service, and a commitment to activities whose purpose is to further the cause of international understanding. The endowment also has an interest in students majoring in education administration, though this is not a requirement for eligibility.

Ann L. Wharton Scholarship Fund

This annual scholarship award is for a student in his/her junior year (with a full year of study remaining) who has demonstrated superior academic performance after overcoming a substantive obstacle or personal challenge. Such obstacles or challenges include, but not limited to initial academic disappointment or failure; a physical challenge; or financial or economic obstacles. In each case, the recipient should have demonstrated in his/her life and University career those qualities exemplified by Ann L. Wharton: courage, hard work, persistence, and generosity to others.

Imagine A Way Scholarship

The purpose of the Imagine A Way Scholarship Endowment is to support scholarships for students who have financial need or who may be among the first generation in their family to attend college.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES: Please fill out the information on the Scholarship Cover Page and select the scholarship for which you are applying. On a separate piece of paper, please describe how you fit the scholarship criteria and why you make a good candidate for your selected scholarship. Include information on any special abilities, leadership positions held, honors received, participation in co-curricular activities, etc. Please limit your answer to one (1) page; all responses must be typed. Applicants may only apply for one scholarship.

****Scholarship recipients must attend Spring Convocation to receive their award.****

Applications must include:

1. Completed cover page.
2. One page, typed essay described in above paragraph.
3. Two letters of recommendation (at least one from a faculty or staff member).
4. An official copy of your transcript from the registrar's office.

The applicant is solely responsible for submitting all of the above components to the Office of Institutional Advancement in Russell House, Room 203, by **February 15th**. The applicant is encouraged to check with the Advancement Office for receipt of all items before the deadline date. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Competitive applicants might be asked for an interview in March. Awarding of the scholarships will take place at Spring Convocation in May.
