WELCOME

Hello and welcome, new Panthers!

This Fall, Plymouth State University is excited to introduce a brand new initiative for first semester students. This competition challenges you to get out of your comfort zone by engaging with the campus community and resources right off the bat.

We've created a bingo board that represents an array of events, traditions, and resources at Plymouth State. By participating in campus opportunities throughout the Fall 2022 semester you will be eligible to win a variety of prizes. The more squares you mark off on each bingo board tier increases your eligibility. Covering all 25 bingo board spots qualifies you to enter for the grand prize, a \$6,000 PSU scholarship! While we only require the completion of the 25 spots to enter for all prizes, we encourage and challenge you to continue participating and attending campus events and traditions- they are all planned with you in mind! We hope that you find your community a PSU through seeing a snapshot of many of the things we love about campus.

It will be important that you read through this guidebook to understand the rules to play Plymouth Jackpot Bingo; making sure that you submit your qualifying events through Canvas within the allotted time. If you have any questions along the way, please contact us at PSU-Orientation@plymouth.edu.

HOW TO PLAY

Step 1: Check Your Email

Each week you will receive an email to your PSU account with upcoming qualifying events to attend.

Step 2: Attend the Event

Make sure to actively attend qualifying events throughout the semester and check-in at the event with your PSU ID.

Step 3: Document the Event

Submit the event to the Plymouth Jackpot Bingo Canvas page within 14 days of attending.

Step 4: Winners Announced in December

RULES

- Students must be enrolled in their first semester at Plymouth State University to participate in the contest
- Students must check in to events, unless otherwise stated on the Canvas page, for credit towards Plymouth Jackpot Bingo
- Events can only be counted towards Plymouth Jackpot Bingo once (i.e., one event cannot be counted towards multiple bingo spots)
- Students must submit events on Canvas within 14 calendar days for credit towards Plymouth Jackpot Bingo
- Only qualifying events listed on weekly emails from "Orientation at Plymouth State" can count for bingo spaces
- Students must be eligible to return to Plymouth State in Spring 2023 to qualify for winning prizes
- Tier 1 & 2 prizes are non-transferable

QUALIFYING EVENTS

BINGO SPOT 1

Online Orientation

Complete the six-module online program created to help students to familiarize themselves with Plymouth State resources and services. This should be completed prior to Panther Days in August, and takes approximately two hours. Online Orientation also includes all required WISE modules (alcohol, marijuana, and consent/respect).

BINGO SPOT 2

Panther Days

Attend Panther Days, which takes place Friday, August 26 – Sunday, August 28th, 2022. Students will need to attend and check-in to the following presentations to fulfill this category: Shot of Reality, The C Word, Freedom to be Yourself, and One Reason Why Not.

BINGO SPOT 3

Student Life Event

Attend an event sponsored by the Student Life Department (Student Engagement, Campus Recreation, Community Impact, and/or New Student Experience) during the Fall Semester.

BINGO SPOT 4

Wellness Event

Attend an event that contributes to physical, mental, spiritual, and/or emotional wellness to fulfill this requirement. Examples include:

- Counseling Center sponsored or co-sponsored event (e.g. Self-Awareness through Self-Expression Group, Mental Health Awareness event).
- Campus Ministries event
- Campus Recreation sponsored events/classes

BINGO SPOT 5

Club/Organization Meeting

Attend a meeting of a club or organization that is recognized on campus.

BINGO SPOT 6

Club/Organization Event

Attend an event hosted by a recognized club or organization on campus that is outside of their regular general member meeting time.

BINGO SPOT 7

Silver Center Event

Attend an event hosted by the Silver Center for the Arts.

BINGO SPOT 8

Residential Life Event

Attend an activity or event hosted by Residential Life.

BINGO SPOT 9

Men's Athletics Game

Attend a men's athletic event. Active membership on a men's athletic team will also fulfill this category

BINGO SPOT 10

Women's Athletics Game

Attend a women's athletic event. Active membership on a women's athletic team will also fulfill this category

BINGO SPOT 11

Diversity, Equity, and Social Justice Event

Attend a diversity, equity, and social justice event.

BINGO SPOT 12

Career Development Opportunity

Attend a career development job fair, event, or program.
Working at an on-campus job will also fulfill this category.

BINGO SPOT 13

Workshop 1: The Courage to Belong

Attending this workshop will fulfill this category. This will focus on self-discovery and how we might call upon our courage in order to cultivate connectedness. Please join the New Student Experience Team as we explore what it means to belong to our campus community.

Students may also fulfill this category by simply completing their 2023 -2024 FAFSA or by setting up a Spring Term 2023 Payment Plan between October 1 and December 1.
