

Here is the data for the 2020-21 cohort. There were 99 completers in this cohort. Currently, 44 of these students are teaching in New Hampshire. Many graduates teach in neighboring New England states; however, this data isn't available for all states. For example, the Massachusetts data base shares the licensure information, but not the place of employment. Column 5 displays the number of program completers teaching in NH, according to the NHDOE Educator Search.
