TCAP stands for Teacher Candidate Assessment of Performance, an acronym created by institutes of higher education in New Hampshire who have collaborated to develop a common capstone experience for all teacher candidates in the state. Every teacher candidate seeking certification from an accredited institution in New Hampshire will participate in TCAP at the end of their certification program. The total score is a 48; a score of 24 or higher is acceptable. This assessment has been crosswalked to the NH ED standards and the InTASC standards. Here is a sample of the of the rubric.
