

NH requires the Praxis II for certain licensure areas. In addition, the Elementary Education and Early Childhood Licensure both require the Foundations of Reading Test. The Praxis II is highly recommended, but not required, prior to graduation. Many graduates choose to teach in Massachusetts, which doesn't accept the Praxis II scores. Massachusetts licensure applicants are required to pass the Massachusetts Tests for Educator Licensure (MTELS). This explains the discrepancy between the number of test takers and the number of program completers. Also, the participation rate for taking the test is lower due to Covid-19. Most completers take the Praxis II during the Spring semester, and testing centers were closed due to the pandemic.
