MINOR IN SPANISH

- Requires only 17-18 credits; a minor could easily complement any major on campus.
- Credits earned in the minor count as general elective credits as well. So, you satisfy elective requirements *and* complete a Spanish minor.

Students who transfer to Plymouth State University and wish to minor in Spanish must take at least one three-credit 3000/4000 level course in Spanish at Plymouth to be granted a Spanish minor.
