A TRADITION STEEPED IN HISTORY

The Academic Procession is a descendant of European religious processions, which began to include teaching faculties in the Middle Ages, when universities were closely associated with the medieval church.

The order used in today's procession has evolved through many years of practice at Plymouth State University. At the front of the line is the faculty marshal, who will carry the University mace, a symbol of authority and unity. The marshal will be followed in the procession by four flag bearers, the president of Plymouth State University, the provost, members of the University System Board of Trustees, honored guests, speakers, vice presidents, and senior class officers. This group is followed by the faculty, who march in order of rank. The faculty is followed by the degree candidates.

THE MACE

The tradition of the academic mace began in the late fourteenth century when two ancient instruments, the royal scepter and the battle mace, were combined to form a symbol of authority of the rector of a university. Today, the academic mace, along with the presidential medallion, signifies that the president of the university is the temporary embodiment of the power, authority, and autonomy vested in the institution.

The faculty marshal carries the academic mace at public events such as Commencement exercises and convocations as a symbol of the special stewardship authority and trust reposed in the faculty for the curriculum and academic affairs of the university. The PSU mace was designed and created by Professor Emeritus of Sculpture Philip Lonergan in 2004.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The Presidential Medallion is the official insignia of the President's Office and is worn on ceremonial occasions. Created when Plymouth State became a university, the medallion embodies parts of the official seal of the University, showing pictorial representations of Rounds Hall, the Old Man of the Mountain, the lamp of enlightenment, and our connection to the outdoors.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The caps, gowns, and hoods seen today have evolved from costumes worn during early religious processions to distinguish church and university members from the laity. In present times, the attire serves to indicate, by style and adornment, the chief academic degree attained, the major field of study, and the college or university attended by the wearer.

THE GOWN

The modern academic costume worn in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code established in 1895. Most gowns are black, but more American colleges and universities now permit the wearing of college colors. The associate's gown and the bachelor's gown are the same. They have long, pointed sleeves, and are untrimmed and worn closed. The master's gown, worn either open or closed, has long, crescent-shaped sleeves. The doctoral gown has black velvet panels down the front, and velvet bars on bell-shaped sleeves.

THE CAP

The customary head covering is either the mortarboard or the Oxford cap. The tassel on the mortarboard cap may be black or of a color indicating the degree. The doctor's tassel is usually gold in color. The tassel is worn over the left front quarter of the mortarboard once the degree has been awarded.

THE HOOD

The hood, which drapes over the back of the gown, carries the greatest symbolism of all the components of the academic costume, and dates back to the twelfth century when it was intended as a head cover or shoulder cape. Its length and width denote the wearer's highest academic achievement. The color of the velvet trim reveals the wearer's major field of study. Linings, which are exposed in the center of the hood as it lies over the back of the gown, indicate the colors of the degree-granting institution.

THE COLORS

In regalia, academic disciplines are noted by color. These colors can be found on undergraduate and master's tassels and on master's and doctoral hoods on the velvet edging.

THE CORD AND STOLE

Cords, medallions, or colored tassels may be worn by some members of academic honor societies to signify their achievements. The standards for this distinction are set by each honor society. The cords are worn around the neck and drape down the front of the gown.

Veterans, active duty personnel, and ROTC students may wear a red, white, and blue cord to acknowledge their service to our country.

Members of several student organizations, University programs, and student athletes may also wear a stole in recognition of that involvement. The stole may be adorned with the emblem(s) of the organization(s) in which the student has participated.

Plymouth State's lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer students who have participated in Lavender Graduation, a ceremony honoring LGBTQ+ students and acknowledging their achievements and contributions to the University, may wear a rainbow cord.

PSU's international students may choose to wear a stole or lapel pin displaying the flag of their home countries. This year features graduate and undergraduate students from Canada, Sweden, and Vietnam.

THE HONORS TASSEL

Green and white tassels distinguish honors baccalaureate graduates. **Summa cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.75–4.0. **Magna cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.50–3.74. **Cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.25–3.49.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

Christopher Steffanci '96

Christopher Steffanci is president and CEO of Columbia Distributing in Seattle Washington, one of the nation's largest beverage distributing companies. Christopher has spent the last 20 years in the wine and beer industry where he has held senior leadership roles in sales, marketing, and strategy.

After receiving his bachelor of science degree in economics, Steffanci began his career with Gallo Wine on the East Coast but over time decided his true passion was in the beer industry. He has since devoted the majority of his energy working for major global and domestic brewers such as Diageo-Guinness USA in various sales/marketing roles, at Heineken USA where he held several senior leadership roles, and as COO of Pabst Brewing Company.

Christopher's high energy and passionate leadership style have been the key drivers behind his successful career. In October 2007, at the age of 34, he was awarded New York's 40 Under 40 award while he was the senior VP of Sales for the US business at Heineken. Christopher is also a member of the Pacific Northwest Young Presidents Organization. He has been featured in several *Beverage Journals* and participated in numerous speaking engagements within the industry.

In addition to his ventures in the hospitality sector, Ryan is also an active real estate developer. He is currently focusing on large-scale development projects, particularly in the realm of entry-level and local housing in luxury destination markets, leveraging opportunities to address housing challenges.

Ryan splits his time between New York City and the Catskills, where he lives with his wife, Emily, and their daughter, Theodora.

Peter S. Cofran '74, '88G

Cofran served in several Plymouth State roles from 1984–07, including as physical education center and home events coordinator and as director of summer conferences. He also served as equipment manager, assistant athletic director, and interim alumni director. Cofran served as the athletic director at Newfound Regional High School from 2007 to 2019 and was Special Olympics New Hampshire director of school unified activities from 2020 to 2022.

His substantial involvement in high school sports includes lengthy coaching stints at Plymouth Regional High School. He has been very active with the New Hampshire Interscholastic Athletic Association (NHIAA), Plymouth Area Little League, and various coaches' and officials' organizations, statewide and nationally, serving on numerous committees in a variety of leadership roles.

Cofran is a former Plymouth State student body president. He was awarded the Van A. Hartman Award as the Outstanding Senior Male (1974); the PSC Alumni Association Alumni Achievement Award (1986); Distinguished Professional, Administrative, or Technical Staff Award (1996), and the PSC Alumni Association Distinguished Alumni Service Award. He has been a Coach of the Year, Athletic Director of the Year, Employee of the Year, and Volunteer of the Year; has received several service awards; and has been named to the New Hampshire Coaches, Plymouth State Athletics, Newfound Regional, and NHIAA halls of fame. A native of Allentown, NH, Cofran currently resides in Plymouth, NH, and devotes his time to many organizations near and dear to him.

2023 DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE TEACHING AWARD

Jennifer DeMoras, '00, '13MBA, DBA, CPA, CMA, Assistant Professor of Accounting

DeMoras's research interests include the costing systems of small- and medium-sized businesses and the use of instructional simulation in accounting education.

She is a member of numerous professional organizations, including serving on the board of the New Hampshire chapter of the Institute of Management Accountants. Her business experience includes roles in operations management in the financial services industry and the owner of multiple small businesses. She believes that teaching is her true calling and has been instructing undergraduate and graduate accounting courses at Plymouth State since 2015.



2023 EXCELLENCE IN FACULTY SERVICE AWARD

Cathie Leblanc, PhD, Professor of Digital Media

LeBlanc started her career at Plymouth State University in 1998 in the computer science and technology department and currently teaches in the communication and media studies program, which she previously chaired. She also served as general education coordinator and is currently program coordinator for the game design major.

She has served as co-organizer of the Cluster Pedagogy Learning Community and has provided key insights that have strengthened the Academic Rebalance program, among other contributions. Her leadership has been integral in aligning the General Education (now HoME) program with the Cluster vision.



2023 DISTINGUISHED TEACHING LECTURER AWARD

Jason Paling, PhD, Teaching Lecturer, Anthropology

Paling began teaching at Plymouth State in 2013 and has taught and developed courses from introductory anthropology to forensic science. He also developed and implemented an international field school in Nicaragua, and students learned archaeological methods while investigating a pre-Columbian site.

As advisor to the Plymouth State University Nicaragua Club from 2014–2020, students helped residents of Managua's poorest barrio, assisted an elementary school, participated in community outreach programs that supported women and their families, and in environmental and sustainability projects including reforestation projects.



2023 DISTINGUISHED UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING AWARD

Anil Waghe, PhD, Professor of Chemistry

Waghe's teaching and scholarship incorporate his industrial and academic experiences in various applied science fields, and he teaches courses in chemistry, criminal justice, and forensic science. The overarching principles of his teaching are Cluster Pedagogy, High Impact Teaching, Soft Skills, and Advising/Mentoring. He believes effective teaching requires active student participation and strives to create an inclusive and engaging learning environment that promotes collaborative learning, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.

Recent research includes exploring the extraction and analysis of medicinal compounds from domestic herbal plants, and projects encompassing environmental science, polymer science, and green organic synthesis.



2023 DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Kim Livingstone, PhD, MSW, Assistant Professor in Social Work, Director of the Social Work Program

Livingstone is a content matter expert, implementation coach, and trainer in facilitating transitions out of homeless services. She has worked with New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services to implement 10 programs across the state to assist individuals transitioning into the community following a psychiatric hospitalization, and NH-DHHS has contracted with PSU to help support the state-wide implementation. She has also worked closely with the Youth Success Project, New Hampshire's Youth Action Board, a group of youth and young adults with lived experience in homelessness involved in solving youth homelessness across the state.



2023 TRANSFORMATIVE TEACHING AWARD

Alison Smith Mitchell, PhD, MSW, MAIS, Assistant Professor in Social Work

For 12 years, Mitchell served as a Court Appointed Special Advocate for children (CASA) volunteer guardian ad litem and was formerly a K–12 educator, administrator, and elected school board member.

Mitchell has worked with preschool-aged children to older adults, specializing in adult women who have experienced interpersonal trauma(s), often in combination with substance use disorder. Her work has involved supporting opioid-affected children and families, the creation of a Children's Advocacy Center, programs supporting kinship caregivers, and wrap-around housing and services for survivors of human trafficking.
