A TRADITION STEEPED IN HISTORY

The Academic Procession is a descendant of European religious processions, which began to include teaching faculties in the Middle Ages, when universities were closely associated with the medieval church.

The order used in today's procession has evolved through many years of practice at Plymouth State University. At the front of the line is the faculty marshal, who will carry the University mace, a symbol of authority and unity. The marshal will be followed in the procession by four flag bearers, the president of Plymouth State University, the provost, members of the University System Board of Trustees, honored guests, speakers, vice presidents, and senior class officers. This group is followed by the faculty, who march in order of rank. The faculty is followed by the degree candidates.

THE MACE

The tradition of the academic mace began in the late fourteenth century when two ancient instruments, the royal scepter and the battle mace, were combined to form a symbol of authority of the rector of a university. Today, the academic mace, along with the presidential medallion, signifies that the president of the university is the temporary embodiment of the power, authority, and autonomy vested in the institution.

The faculty marshal carries the academic mace at public events such as Commencement exercises and convocations as a symbol of the special stewardship authority and trust reposed in the faculty for the curriculum and academic affairs of the university. The PSU mace was designed and created by Professor Emeritus of Sculpture Philip Lonergan in 2004.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The Presidential Medallion is the official insignia of the President's Office and is worn on ceremonial occasions. Created when Plymouth State became a university, the medallion embodies parts of the official seal of the University, showing pictorial representations of Rounds Hall, the Old Man of the Mountain, the lamp of enlightenment, and our connection to the outdoors.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The caps, gowns, and hoods seen today have evolved from costumes worn during early religious processions to distinguish church and university members from the laity. In present times, the attire serves to indicate, by style and adornment, the chief academic degree attained, the major field of study, and the college or university attended by the wearer.

THE GOWN

The modern academic costume worn in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code established in 1895. Most gowns are black, but more American colleges and universities now permit the wearing of college colors. The associate's gown and the bachelor's gown are the same. They have long, pointed sleeves, and are untrimmed and worn closed. The master's gown, worn either open or closed, has long, crescent-shaped sleeves. The doctoral gown has black velvet panels down the front, and velvet bars on bell-shaped sleeves.

THE CAP

The customary head covering is either the mortarboard or the Oxford cap. The tassel on the mortarboard cap may be black or of a color indicating the degree. The doctor's tassel is usually gold in color. The tassel is worn over the left front quarter of the mortarboard once the degree has been awarded.

THE HOOD

The hood, which drapes over the back of the gown, carries the greatest symbolism of all the components of the academic costume, and dates back to the twelfth century when it was intended as a head cover or shoulder cape. Its length and width denote the wearer's highest academic achievement. The color of the velvet trim reveals the wearer's major field of study. Linings, which are exposed in the center of the hood as it lies over the back of the gown, indicate the colors of the degree-granting institution.

THE COLORS

In regalia, academic disciplines are noted by color. These colors can be found on undergraduate and master's tassels and on master's and doctoral hoods on the velvet edging.

THE CORD AND STOLE

Cords, medallions, or colored tassels may be worn by some members of academic honor societies to signify their achievements. The standards for this distinction are set by each honor society. The cords are worn around the neck and drape down the front of the gown.

Veterans, active duty personnel, and ROTC students may wear a red, white, and blue cord to acknowledge their service to our country.

Members of several student organizations, University programs, and student athletes may also wear a stole in recognition of that involvement. The stole may be adorned with the emblem(s) of the organization(s) in which the student has participated.

Plymouth State's lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer students who have participated in Lavender Graduation, a ceremony honoring LGBTQ+ students and acknowledging their achievements and contributions to the University, may wear a rainbow cord.

PSU's international students may choose to wear a stole or lapel pin displaying the flag of their home countries. This year features graduate and undergraduate students from Canada, China, Costa Rica, Saudi Arabia, Sweden, and the United Kingdom.

THE HONORS TASSEL

Green and white tassels distinguish honors baccalaureate graduates. **Summa cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.75–4.0. **Magna cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.50–3.74. **Cum laude** is granted to a graduate with a GPA of 3.25–3.49.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

Todd Angilly '99

Todd Angilly '99 has worked in the Massachusetts criminal justice system for many years and currently serves as director of workforce development at the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security. He's perhaps best known, however, as the talented anthem singer for the Boston Bruins, and he'll share his remarkable journey with PSU students when he delivers Undergraduate Commencement remarks.

After graduating from Plymouth State with a bachelor's degree in music, Angilly was accepted into the opera program at the New England Conservatory in Boston. While studying at the conservatory, he worked part-time at Fenway Park, where he would often practice singing while he worked. He was soon discovered by a member of the front office staff who invited him to perform the national anthem at a Red Sox game, and he soon became a regular in the rotation at Fenway Park.

Angilly famously filled-in for renowned Boston Bruins anthem singer Rene Rancourt on-and-off for several seasons and was named the franchise's official anthem singer upon Rancourt's retirement in October 2019. He has performed the anthem for all five New England professional sports teams.

Angilly credits PSU as a formative experience that sent ultimately sent him to center ice. "I wouldn't be doing what I'm doing if it wasn't for the music staff at Plymouth State," he says.



HONORARY DOCTORATE RECIPIENT

Peter Bauer

Peter Bauer is co-founder and CEO at cyber security company, Mimecast, which he launched in 2003 in London, UK. As of the end of 2022, Mimecast employs over 2000 people with offices in seven countries, and serves over 40,000 customers, from small and medium enterprises to some of the largest organizations in the world. Peter was born and raised in South Africa. He chose to skip university, preferring to study marketing management part-time whilst starting his first business, a school supplies company. In the mid-nineties, Peter trained as a Microsoft systems engineer and co-founded a small software business in his native South Africa, which was later bought by a publicly traded firm. He then moved to the UK where Mimecast was founded. In 2011, he arrived in Boston, to lead Mimecast's growth and subsequent IPO in North America, and in 2022 Mimecast became a private company once again, acquired by Permira, a private equity firm, for \$5.8bn. Peter and his wife have three children. They are supporters of the Plymouth State Enactus team and the Panther Pitch program, which promotes innovation and entrepreneurship for the next generation of change leaders. Peter believes the world needs more entrepreneurs. He enjoys visiting campus to inspire students to find their own passion and create a business model to support their ideas.

REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 50TH REUNION CLASS OF 1973

Ken '73, P'01 and Jackie Moulton '73, '02G, P'01

Jackie graduated from PSC *magna cum laude* with a BS in physical education in 1973. She played field hockey and lacrosse. In 2002, Jackie completed her master's in education degree at PSC.

Jackie taught elementary, junior, and high school physical education, coaching multiple sports, and starting several afterschool outdoor clubs. She has hiked the Appalachian Trail and has been an active member of the New Hampshire Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance, receiving its Elementary Teacher of the Year award in 2002

Ken also graduated from PSC with a BS in physical education in 1973. He played baseball and soccer and was an active member of the student body. Ken had a 47-year career as a realtor and developer, serving on the Concord Board of Realtors and is a past recipient of the Realtor of the Year award.

Ken has served on numerous boards, including chairing the PSU President's Council and was a gubernatorial appointee to the USNH Board of Trustees. Ken is a 2019 recipient of the *Ut Prosim* (That I May Serve) award from the PSU Alumni Association.

Ken and Jackie have been married for 52 years and live in Concord, NH. They have two adult children and one grandchild. 2023 is the 50th anniversary of their graduation from Plymouth State.



**2022 DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE TEACHING AWARD****Roxana Wright '01MBA, DBA, Professor of Management**

Wright currently teaches undergraduate and MBA courses in strategy and operations management, as well as courses for the doctor of education program. She has authored publications and conference presentations focused on firm performance, supply chain management, and strategies of multinational enterprises.

Her mission is to guide students toward realizing their full potential. Wright is passionate about translating current research and theory into applied consulting projects and studies in which students provide ideas and solutions to organizations. Her most recent work combines business and economics analysis to examine US states' globalization in terms of foreign direct investments presence and international business activity.

**2022 EXCELLENCE IN FACULTY SERVICE AWARD****Hilary Swank, PhD; Associate Professor of Elementary Education and Youth Development**

Swank teaches courses in child development, learning sciences, and youth development. She is passionate about helping her students develop skills to make sense out of challenging or conflicting information to be better educators in and out of the classroom.

Swank's research currently focuses primarily on afterschool program quality and program outcomes. She recently wrapped up a partnership with the New Hampshire Department of Education in which she completed two cycles as the statewide evaluator for federally funded afterschool programs. Swank also works with after-school programs and other community organizations across the state to coordinate field experiences for students in the elementary education and youth development program.

**2022 DISTINGUISHED TEACHING LECTURER AWARD****Lara Saffo, JD, Teaching Lecturer, Criminal Justice**

Saffo joined the Criminal Justice program in 2011, and has taught Criminal Procedure, Criminal Law, The Individual and the Law, and Juvenile Delinquency.

She currently serves as chief compliance officer for Mount Prospect Academy and the Vermont Permanency Initiative, alliances of nonprofit academic and behavioral health programs with a continuum of care model that offers support to children and families of all ages.

Saffo previously was the county attorney for Grafton County and has prosecuted hundreds of cases, specializing in sexual assault and domestic violence cases, as well as alternative sentencing solutions, such as drug court and mental health court.

**2022 DISTINGUISHED UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING AWARD****Brigid O'Donnell, PhD; Associate Professor of Developmental Biology**

O'Donnell is an integrative biologist who studies wild brook trout and aquatic insects. Her research links across biological scales and bridges field and laboratory investigations to better understand biological phenomena. She teaches courses in developmental biology, evolution, and ecological developmental biology, in addition to general education courses and a Tackling a Wicked Problem course centering on pollinator declines.

In her research, O'Donnell partners with colleagues and New Hampshire Fish and Game, The Conservation Fund, and the Pemigewasset Chapter of Trout Unlimited in working to protect wild brook trout populations in central and northern New Hampshire.

2022 DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**Abby Goode, PhD, Assistant Professor of Early American Literature**

Goode specializes in environmental studies and American literature and culture. Her work has been supported by fellowships from the American Council of Learned Societies (ACLS), the American Association of University Women (AAUW), the American Antiquarian Society, the Institute for Citizens and Scholars, and the First Book Institute at the Center for American Literary Studies at Penn State.

Goode has served as a leader and steward of open, interdisciplinary, and project-based pedagogies within and beyond PSU, publishing peer-reviewed scholarship, speaking at national conferences, and mentoring faculty across the disciplines.

**2022 TRANSFORMATIVE TEACHING AWARD****Abby Goode, PhD, Assistant Professor of Early American Literature**

Goode began teaching at Plymouth State in 2016, and has constantly strived to improve her teaching and energize the teaching culture across higher education. She consistently encourages students to carve their own paths, to be fearless and innovative in confronting unsolved problems, and to build enduring, intellectual habits that extend far beyond the classroom. Her teaching focuses on creating opportunities for student leadership, open education, and community engagement, even after the semester is over.
